## Who are we and what do we do?

### We are the UK's Influential Voice of Business and General Aviation

#### *'Supporting Businesses in Business and General Aviation'*

- BBGA represents the interests of member companies at a regional level when we need to progress issues with bodies like airports, local communities, or divisions of government agencies.
- At a National level BBGA has recognised positions in several working groups within the CAA and DfT providing direct access to CAA CEO and the aviation minister.
- The BBGA has access to all the government offices and is the first point of contact for consultations on our sector.
- At a European level, the association has access to EASA and the Commission through the vehicle which is ECOGAS (European Council of General Aviation Support). This allows us to work with the top five-member state associations. Together we have 700 members to refer to when making our inputs to the European regulator.
- We have access to the international forum of IBAC (International Business Aviation Council). We are a founder of this group which allows all the international associations across the globe to work together to help provide strategic direction for our sector. The IBAC secretariat operates from the same offices as ICAO and are able, therefore, to lobby directly for long term changes on our behalf, to help shape our sector in the long term.
- BBGA is working hard to improve the perception of our sector and has strong links with the EBAA who are developing a significant marketing programme to help that process. We have full and unrestricted access to the material generated to help market our sector.

## **BBGA BENEFIT TO INDUSTRY**

- BBGA has a strong, positive and active relationship with several other associations. Since 2016 we have an agreement in place so that anyone joining the BBGA now also gets membership of EBAA for a single fee. Businesses in the UK are now only able to access EBAA through BBGA membership. This agreement provides members with many benefits from both associations including events and workgroups which are designed to address industry problems.
- BBGA has an alliance with BHA, AOPA and ARPAS, so that we can talk to government and focus on the issues of the day that will help our community. The focus historically was more regulation focused and in practice much of the help we need is to remove roadblocks, remove unnecessary red tape and facilitate growth in the UK to help industry and the UK economy simultaneously.
- The government is still keen to see the UK become the best GA community in the world. Industry is also keen to see UK aviation to be a leading player in the global market. Therefore, working as an alliance it allows us to focus our voice and become a first point of contact for all consultations associated with our community. Far better to have one voice acting together than it is to have several voices making separate demands.
- BBGA board members are active on several All-Party political groups, which offers us the opportunity to lobby in both houses of Parliament.

## BBGA RELATIONSHIPS EXPLAINED

It is worth mentioning that all the relationships shown below have been retained and, in some ways, strengthened with the advent of remote working. Certainly, everyone across the globe has adapted to ensure that we retain good contact.

The flow chart which follows shows the relationships that BBGA has across National, European and International forums. It demonstrates how your instructions, as members, are reflected into various organisations or government agencies to help impact change where change is required.

***The starting point for this process is to utilise the workgroups which are industry led bodies focused on dealing with issues that impact your part of our industry.***

- **Airworthiness** – The work of engineering, maintenance, manufacturing, training and component distribution activities is now closely integrated with the UKASF to provide the single industry voice.
- **Operations** – Covers flight operations and much of the ground operations activities which combine to deliver services to our clients in commercial General Aviation across a wide spectrum of products.
- **Fixed Base Operations** – This workgroup is very active in the current climate with border force requirements, more stringent measures and managing the current pandemic issues. This group will face many challenges in the coming years post Brexit and pandemic.
- **Membership group** – This activity is focused on the value and benefit offered to our members. The output of this group ranges from event delivery and ensuring our sector messaging is appropriate, to the basic marketing of our activities.
- **Sustainability Workgroup** – This group examines the sustainability targets, aims and objectives across aviation and how Biz Av is affected. The group will comment on consultations involving the govt. Jet Zero and SAF targets.

The output of these workgroups is strategically controlled through your BBGA Board. The secretariat ensures that the requisite actions are delivered through the most appropriate channel.

## **BBGA RELATIONSHIPS EXPLAINED**

### **EBAA**

We have a formal link with EBAA through an agreement which was redefined and signed in 2022.

This agreement with EBAA gives UK members a single point of access whilst accessing the benefits of both BBGA & EBAA membership. Joint working groups and a national association forum generate significant benefit for all our members.

### **ECOGAS (European Council of General Aviation Support)**

ECOGAS is now established as an association in France based at FNAM in Paris, FNAM are the national French association. Our access to EASA remains the same and we can still reflect industry's position through our European ECOGAS members.

ECOGAS focuses on the airworthiness and training aspects which EBAA does not and so between us we have a broad base with which we can address issues to EASA. ECOGAS has some 700 members through its associations. This gives us a great voice to represent SMEs with both the Commission and EASA in a European context. ECOGAS has formal seats on all the EASA advisory boards.

We have also co-opted the European Independent Maintenance Group (EIMG) on to the board of ECOGAS so that we could enhance the European credentials of the EIMG. The EIMG has formal seats with EASA just like ECOGAS and is the voice of UKASF in that forum. As a UK focused body, the EIMG might have been excluded by EASA without this link to ECOGAS.

### **GA for Business (GA4Biz)**

We have formed an alliance with BHA, AOPA, ARPAS and the BBGA so that we can talk to government and focus on the issues of the day that will help our community. The focus was historically more regulation focused and in practice much of the help we need is to remove roadblocks, remove unnecessary red tape and facilitate growth in the UK to help industry and the UK economy simultaneously.

The government is still keen to see the UK become the best GA community in the world. Industry is also keen to see UK aviation be a leading player in the global market. Therefore, working as an alliance allows us to focus our voice and become a first point of contact for all consultations associated with our community. Far better to have one voice acting together than to have several voices making separate demands.

### **GAAC**

We also work with the General Aviation Awareness Council. This group has a particular focus on managing the status of our network of airfields throughout the UK. Given the status of the UK in terms of the density and utilisation of our airspace it is vital that we ensure that we have the infrastructure to support our business into the future.

### **APPG**

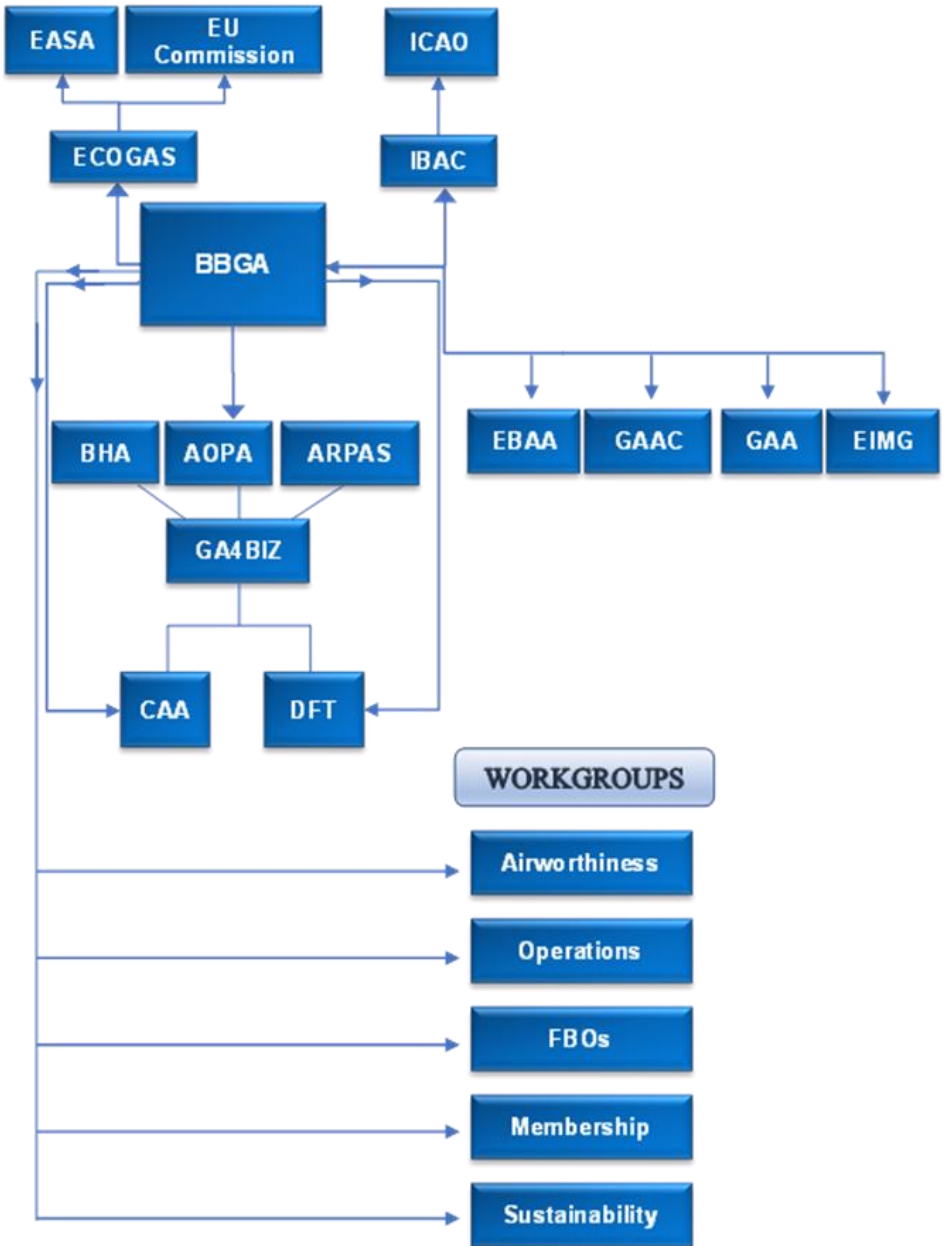
The All-Party political groups are a useful body for us to interact with and this allows us to challenge things that are not necessarily being responded to by the government of the day. We currently have seats in three of the groups. Tax & Regulations, Airfields and Next Generation/STEM. This APPG for GA initially has been evolving and the Next Generation group is now treated as for aviation, which is something we have been trying to encourage for several years. Given the participants in the APPGs from both houses we can raise questions in both forums should we give additional focus on a subject. For clarity ministers cannot participate in APPG activities because in many cases it might cross the current cabinet policy.

### **IBAC (International Business Aviation Council)**

As a founder member of this group, the BBGA has a forum to work with all the major international associations across the world so that we can help shape the future direction of our sector. IBAC is based in Canada in the same offices as ICAO which puts us in an ideal position to directly influence the long-term legislation which drives our part of aviation.

The other major activity with IBAC is the development of industry standards with ISBAO and ISBAH. This is a notable example of industry leading the way on things that matter. By driving the standards we help minimise the need for regulators to impose regulations.

# WHAT ARE AVIATION SERVICES AVIATION SERVICES IN GA

There has been no progression of any bilateral agreement with the EU in 2023. Even following the Windsor framework agreement, and as such there is no expectation of any negotiations with the EU which would allow any discussions to take place between EASA and the UK CAA. There is no political imperative which will cause negotiations to start through 2024. If there were a change in government at the end of 2024 it is again unlikely that there will be any immediate call for a review of the UK's relationship with the EU. It is also likely that aviation would not be seen as a priority issue even if those negotiations were started and therefore it would be 2026 at the earliest before anything is likely to be discussed for our sector.

We are also facing a similar situation with the USA, and it is clear that with the current democratic party in power the chances of any bilateral trade agreement with the USA is effectively at a standstill. If there were to be a change of government in the USA we might well find that a trade agreement with the USA could be accelerated if previous commitments are to be believed.

Our CAA ,with DfT support, has continued to enter into bilateral agreements with non-EU partners across the globe which offers some progress for OEM's and for their support services. With these non-EU agreements we are able to access some new markets and generate new business opportunities.

With our regular updates from WingX we have seen our markets in business aviation return to promising levels and even scheduled airline colleagues are seeing their flying hours return to levels seen in 2019. Whether the yield available in those markets is as strong as it once was and whether the propensity to travel for business reasons will be the same, only time will tell.

## **Business Aviation NCC**

Business Aviation includes NCC operations in which whole aircraft are chartered by clients and corporate operations in which a company owns and operates its own aircraft using professional pilots. Business Aviation provides industry and commerce with speed and flexibility of operation. It enables busy entrepreneurs to complete trips in a day which otherwise would involve complex and time-wasting scheduled services.

## **AVIATION SERVICES IN GA**

The value to business leaders is significant and allows them to grow their businesses in the most cost-effective way. With market changes post-pandemic, retaining this as a vibrant market for the UK is central to regrowing the economy to create employment and contribute to GDP.

The biggest challenge the community faces is the perception that our community does not support sustainability and in fact is a major contributor to failures in net reaching zero targets. The evidence does not support this position; however, the environmentalists continue to use subjective rhetoric which many people in society believe. It is important that we focus on our desire to embrace future technology and show that we want to manage the transition responsibly so that we retain the UK's position in both leading that change and encouraging greater inward investment to the UK. Our community is a fundamental part of helping to enable this entire process.

## Fractional Ownership

Fractional Ownership programmes are well established in Business Aviation and have greatly increased the number of Business Aviation users. Companies running these programmes will sell users a fractional part of a specific aircraft which remains the property of the buyer and can be traded like any other asset.



The community using this pathway will likely extend their use on future platforms in autonomous transportation.

The UK Government and CAA still do not recognise fractional ownership in the UK even though it is accepted throughout the EU and USA. We really should be levelling this up going forward.

## Air Ambulance and Emergency Services

Increasing use of aeroplanes and helicopters by the Emergency Services means improved reaction and mobility for police and ambulance services.

The UK's air ambulance services have the capability to transport medical supplies, urgently needed transplant organs and repatriate critically ill or injured patients whose lives would be threatened if not for General Aviation aircraft.

Many aspects of the Safety of Life Service are now being provided by new unmanned vehicles and our colleagues in ARPAS are helping to push this forward.

It is vital that the UK reintroduces the 3D navigation facilities previously provided by EGNOS, otherwise we might see an unfortunate levelling down of the services provided to many regional areas.

## Pilot Training

Pilot Training is changing significantly both because of the current demand and because of the access to what were previous markets with EASA certification. We can deliver some of the best training in world and many potential clients still hold that belief. However, without bilateral acceptance of our trained aviators our ATOs in the UK are now left at a significant disadvantage to our colleagues in the EU unless they can negotiate some form of acceptance.

# AVIATION SERVICES IN GA

## Agricultural, Aerial Survey and Aerial Photography



The advent of drones for both commercial and personal use is a rapidly emerging market. There are already vehicles capable of carrying significant payloads of several hundred kilograms. In addition, we see applications to introduce personal delivery of purchased items from some of the largest distributors.

Much of what we may have undertaken using conventional fixed and rotary wing aircraft can now be undertaken using drones and delivered more effectively in more challenging environments.



This is a rapidly developing sector and something that we need to embrace fully as an aviation community in order to ensure that it delivers benefit to clients and members of the public. At the same time, we need to maintain a safe and secure network for all other aviation activities.

### **Airworthiness**

We continued our Airworthiness relationships across aviation in what was a virtual driven process and maintained our dialogue with the CAA throughout 2023. We have further developed a single body for aviation services that includes BBGA, Rotary with BHA, Drones with ARPAS, Aircraft Operators with AOPA, Airlines and MROs – this group is titled GA4BIZ and is recognised by both CAA and DfT.

### **Support Services**

There are many additional services provided to the General Aviation community and these form a vital part of the process to acquire and manage your aviation assets. Legal advisors, Finance providers, Insurers and combined services which are central to working in a global market.

## **Airfields and FBO's**

Our FBO networks will provide a vital resource in terms of traffic to and from the UK as we push for economic recovery. The work to make the UK the ideal trading partner because we are easy and cost effective to work with is the central theme for us emerging from the pandemic.

The FBO workgroup continues to be a very dynamic body lead by Jason Hayward of Universal and it has made several challenges through 2023 which have resulted in benefit to our membership.

We do have unfinished business with Government and airfields regarding the treatment of our community as an Ad Hoc user of slots and if it were not for the market conditions, we would be severely limited by noise and night-time slots at several key London airfields. The next review is not until 2025 even though we have a very logical structured argument to allow continued access of our historical use of night slots as a minimum requirement.

We have formed an alliance with BHA, AOPA, ARPAS and the BBGA so that we can talk to government and focus on the issues of the day that will help our community. ## THE MICHAEL WHEATLEY AWARD 2025

### **BBGA CEO Marc Bailey is this year's outstanding contribution to aviation award recipient**

Marc Bailey, CEO of The British Business General Aviation Association, is this year's recipient of the prestigious Michael Wheatley Award for Outstanding Services to Aviation. Marc celebrates 15 years steering the largest national business aviation association in Europe, following a four-decade career working with blue chip aerospace organisations including British Airways and Cobham. He started his career as a technician apprentice with BA predecessor BOAC at London Heathrow.

Presenting him with the accolade coinciding with the Association's annual conference and AGM on 11 March at London's Royal Leonardo Hotel, London City, BBGA Chair Aoife O'Sullivan thanked Marc for his stellar contribution on behalf of the Association's near 200-members, including successfully navigating BBGA through the pandemic.

Drawing on his strengths as a professional aviation engineer, Marc's achievements at BBGA include working tirelessly on the progression of JAA, through to the inception of EASA; representing ECOGAS, while serving the original EASA advisory board for many years. Under Marc's stewardship BBGA established an active Board of directors and the creation of specialist working groups to better serve its members.

In 2016 he negotiated a joint agreement between BBGA and the European Business Aviation Association, enabling all UK members to receive membership of EBAA and BBGA as one, delivering closer ties between the two trade associations.

Marc has earned the respect of the Department for Transport and UK Civil Aviation Authority. He established General Aviation for Business (GA4Biz) as a collaboration with the British Helicopter Association (BHA); ARPAS, the Drone Association and the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association. Such co-operation has proved to be highly effective and vital to the future development of aviation as this 2025 annual conference attests with its theme '*Running Together.*'

## THE MICHAEL WHEATLEY AWARD 2025

Marc Bailey worked as a Part 66 B1/B2/C engineer before graduating to line engineer and subsequently taking management roles with British Airways including Chief Project Engineer for the Boeing 777 and Chief Fleet Engineer for Concorde, Airbus and the BAC 1-11. Prior to joining BBGA Marc held the role of Head of Quality, Continuing Airworthiness and Training at Cobham Aviation Services (formerly FR Aviation), an organisation he joined in 1998. He

holds a degree in Air Transport Engineering from The City University and an MBA from Lancaster University.

### Passionate about next gen

Marc is passionate about fostering the next generation of aviation professionals with his commitment to skills and training for the industry. Always at the forefront of discussions with Government and the CAA on the matter, he has worked with TRS to create the Aviation Skills Retention platform, latterly the recruitment platform. Here he provided an effective link between Government and industry, enabling the facility to be free to use at point of contact.

Marc chairs an impressive list of key industry groups and/or holds formal board positions which support aviation. This includes: Chair of the United Kingdom Airworthiness Strategic Forum (UKASF); Chair of the European Continued Airworthiness Group (ECAG); Chair of the CAA Finance and Service Forum (FSF); President and Chair of the European Council of General Aviation Support (ECOGAS); Chair of General Aviation for Business (GA4Biz); Board member and director of the General Aviation Awareness Council (GAAC) and Member of Next Gen Aviation Staff, Airfields, Tax and Regulations under the UK APPG (All-Party Political Groups for Aviation.)

## INTRODUCTION TO IBAC

### *Keeping Business Flying Around the World For The Industry, By The Industry*

The International Business Aviation Council's mission is to serve the diverse needs of business aviation across the globe in international regulatory and policy making venues.

Founded in 1981, the International Business Aviation Council (IBAC) is a non-profit, member supported, international trade association with official observer status at the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), the United Nations Specialized Agency for aviation matters in Montreal, Canada.

IBAC represents business aviation associations around the globe—and therefore operators and the industry broadly—to ensure global aviation standards developed at ICAO reflect business aviation needs. At ICAO, 192 Member States and 46 non-governmental organizations work together to develop international Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) that promote a safe, efficient, secure, economically sustainable, and environmentally responsible international aviation industry. In turn, States apply the SARPs in national law or regulations to ensure that their respective operators and national systems meet internationally agreed standards.

The IBAC team promotes an industry-wide safety culture through its two programmes: The International Standards for Business Aircraft Operations (IS-BAOTM) and International Standard for Business Aircraft Handling (IS-BAHTM). Both programmes are voluntary, global codes of best practice that assist operators and ground handlers build safer, more efficient operations.

As part of its services to its members, IBAC also provides Aircrew Identification Cards that meet ICAO standards and are recognized by authorities around the world. These are available only for member operators of IBAC member associations at [IBAC.org](http://IBAC.org).

## IS-BAH

The International Standard for Business Aircraft Handling (IS-BAH™) is designed to enhance the safety and efficiency of ground handling operations through implementation of globally recognized industry best practices that are appropriate to the scale and nature of the operations for Fixed Based Operations (FBO) and Business Aircraft Handling Agencies (BAHA).

The International Business Aviation Council (IBAC) supported by BBGA and its other member associations, with the help of the National Air Transportation Association (NATA) and other industry partners, developed the IS-BAH as a tool to help States, service providers, and international general aviation operators meet their obligations under ICAO Annex 19 on Safety Management Systems (SMS). They did this by positively identifying organisations who have adopted and implemented an industry Standard that follows the same ICAO SMS structure they are obliged to follow themselves.

IS-BAH features, at its core, the SMS concept and was the first to bring it to the ground handling community. It also includes a registration process, auditor credentialing, audit approval process, as well as a manual and fully integrated implementation guide. The SMS component allows an IS-BAH registered FBO/BAHA to gain recognition for having a well-founded safety management development process in place. Maturity of the FBO/BAHA's SMS is a critical factor in the long-term recognition of the use of industry best practices that conform to ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices.

From an aircraft operator's perspective:

IS-BAO is designed specifically for aviation departments and small operators. Its fundamental purpose is to foster standardized, safe, and highly professional aircraft operations while striving for a risk-averse safety culture.

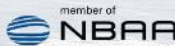

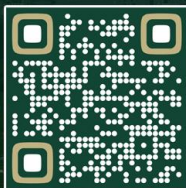
